



PACKING LIST

General Guidelines: Laundry facilities are not available. Work clothes will get dirty, sweaty, painted and tarred. We recommend you pack inexpensive clothing purchased at yard sales or thrift stores and items you would not mind getting really dirty and/or toss at the end of the day or week.)

Bedding & Personal Care

Sleeping Mattress (Cots are available)
Sheets, pillow, blankets or sleeping bag
Bath towels/washcloths & flip-flops for shower
Personal toiletries,
Soap/deodorant/shampoo/toothbrush/ toothpaste/etc.

Leisure Clothes:

Shorts or pants, T-shirts, blouses
Sleepwear, underwear, socks
Regular shoes or sandals
Light jacket

Working Clothes:

Shirts with sleeves and long pants must be worn at all times at the work site.
We recommend hard-soled shoes at the work site and tennis shoes when working on a roof.
(No flip-flops, sandals or open-toed shoes at the worksite.)

Basic Tool/Job Site List For Each Volunteer:

**Safety Protection Is Mandatory.*

We Recommend You Bring Your Own To Insure Best Fit.

Nail Apron – helpful to have one.

Hammer - bring if you have one.

Measuring Tape – bring if you have one.

N95 Dust Mask

Water Bottle

Sun gasses (inexpensive)

Ball cap or hat, Bandanas

Chap Stick, Sunscreen

Insect repellent

Other Recommended Items:

Rain gear
Flashlight (for midnight bathroom runs)
Bible (if you have one you like to use)

WHAT NOT TO BRING!

Matches, lighters, cigarettes, anything flammable, illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons, personal knives,
NO VALUABLES and/or large amounts of cash. Please do not bring any electronic devices to the work site; however, if you must bring these, it is recommended that these items be left in your work vehicle and not accessed during the workday. This includes cell phones, I-Pads, etc. These items are not appropriate at a work site.

First Aid Kits for each team
